Course Objective:

To assess the skills and knowledge to conduct civil construction dozer operations.

Course Outcome:

On successful completion, participants will be issued with a competency card.

Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical: note one machine per operator.
Courses are normally 4 hours in duration and are run on demand.

Course Content

- Conduct routine checks
- Plan work
- Check controls and equipment
- Shift Loads
- Shut down equipment
- Secure site

Pre-requisites

Machine assessments occur only when the participant can demonstrate competency, or with a logbook, signed declaration stating their machine experience or a 3rd party declaration from their employer with machinery operated and position/experience held.

- Students must be 18 years of age, be able to speak and understand basic English to communicate to a level to perform their duties and hold a current driver's license.
- Photo Identification : driver's license, passport or proof of age card
- Long sleeve shirt
- Steel capped boots
- Long trousers

Cost per participant includes learning materials and qualifications (refer to fee schedule)
Subsidies available for building and construction industry participants with a valid CITB eligible worker ID number
