Course Outcome:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry. This is Nationally Recognised Training.

Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is theory based, 1 day (6 hours) and courses are run on demand/as required.

Course Content

- Identify and understand roles, responsibilities and rights of duty holders
- Understand WHS communication and reporting processes
- Apply the principles of risk management
- Identify common hazards and control measures
- Interpret and apply safety information and documentation
- Use safe work practices
- Respond to WHS incidents

Pre-requisites

All students must have a unique student identifier (USI) to obtain their nationally accredited certificate or qualification. To apply for a USI go to www.usi.gov.au

- Students must be 18 years of age, be able to speak and understand basic English to communicate to a level to perform their duties
- Photo Identification : driver's license, passport or proof of age card
- Long sleeve shirt
- Steel capped boots
- Long trousers
