Course Objective:

To provide participants with the skills and knowledge to conduct forklift operations in accordance with Safe Work Australia's National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

Course Outcome:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for TLILIC2001 Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck.

Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical: 2 days (depending on experience*)
Declaration of experience or log book must be presented demonstrating hours of experience.
Courses are run on demand/as required.

Course Content

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Shift loads
- Shut down equipment
- Secure site

Pre-requisites

All students must have a unique student identifier (USI) to obtain their nationally accredited certificate or qualification. To apply for a USI go to www.usi.gov.au

- Students must be 18 years of age, be able to speak and understand basic English to communicate to a level to perform their duties and hold a current driver's license.
- Photo Identification : driver's license, passport or proof of age card
- Long sleeve shirt
- Steel capped boots
- Long trousers

Cost per participant includes learning materials and qualifications (refer to fee schedule). Subsidies are available for building and construction industry participants with a valid CITB eligible worker ID number.
