



## RIIMPO323D Conduct civil construction dozer operations

#### Course Objective:

Provide participants with the skills and knowledge to conduct dozer operations in the civil construction industry.

#### Course Outcome:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a wallet sized card and Statement of Attainment – RIIMPO323D Conduct civil construction dozer operations. This is a module from the RII30815 training package – Certificate III in Civil Construction Plant Operations.

#### Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical: note one machine per operator.

This unit is competency based e.g. log book and or declaration of experience is required.

Courses are run on demand. The dozer can only be conducted on the participant's work site.

#### Course Content

- Plan and prepare
- Conduct machine preoperational checks
- Operate dozer
- Lift, carry and place materials
- Select, remove and fit attachments
- Relocate dozer
- Carry out machine operator maintenance
- Clean up

#### Pre-requisites

All students must have a unique student identifier (USI) to obtain their nationally accredited certificate or qualification. To apply for a USI go to [www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au)

- Students must be 18 years of age, be able to speak and understand basic English to communicate to a level to perform their duties and hold a current driver's license.
- Photo Identification : driver's license, passport or proof of age card
- Long sleeve shirt
- Steel capped boots
- Long trousers
