Course Outcome:

On successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment - RIIMPO326E Conduct civil construction water cart operations. This is a module from the RII training package – RII30815 Certificate III in Civil Construction Plant Operations.

Assessment and Course Delivery

Assessment is both theory and practical – 2 days for Beginners and 1 Day Refresher training for experienced (depending on amount of experience*)

Courses are run on demand/as required at our Burton training facility.

Course Content

- Plan and prepare
- Conduct machine pre operational checks
- Operate water cart
- Load, transport and distribute water
- Carry out driver maintenance
- Clean up

Pre-requisites

All students must have a unique student identifier (USI) to obtain their nationally accredited certificate or qualification. To apply for a USI go to www.usi.gov.au

- Students must be 18 years of age, be able to speak and understand basic English to communicate to a level to perform their duties
- Photo Identification : driver's license, passport or proof of age card
- Long sleeve shirt
- Steel capped boots
- Long trousers
